

Head of Communications Champions Global Unity Against Israel's Crimes



At the "Gaza: The Litmus Test of Humanity" panel, Head of Communications Prof. Burhanettin Duran drew attention to the world's conscience being greater than Israel.

During his keynote speech Prof. Duran underlined how nations have come together to oppose Israel's genocide explaining that "the international community is putting pressure on the leaders".

The publication informs the global public on how each journalist was killed while paying tribute to the martyrs.

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Turkish Call for Justice in New York

The Directorate of Communications held "The Search for Justice in the International System" panel in New York. The event at the Turkevi Centre provided a platform to discuss the UN Security Council System. Attendees remarked that global institutions should not be serving the interests of certain countries, instead they should advocate justice and peace for all.

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Examining the International Community's Humanity

The Directorate of Communications headquarters played host to the "Gaza: The Litmus Test of Humanity" panel. The event had a special emphasis on media representation of Israel's genocide in Gaza. Murders of journalists as well as the inhumane conditions they work in due to Israel's actions were all covered throughout the panel.

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President Erdoğan Urges Global Action to End Atrocities in Gaza

Addressing the United Nations General Assembly, President Erdoğan called on world leaders to stand with the oppressed Palestinian people, emphasizing that humanity has not witnessed such brutality in the past. Highlighting that Israel has killed one child every hour over the last 23 months, President Erdoğan underlined that these are not statistics but innocent lives lost. As marked by President Erdoğan, “Today is the day to stand upright by the oppressed Palestinians in the name of humanity.”

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President Erdoğan Meets with Secretary-General Guterres

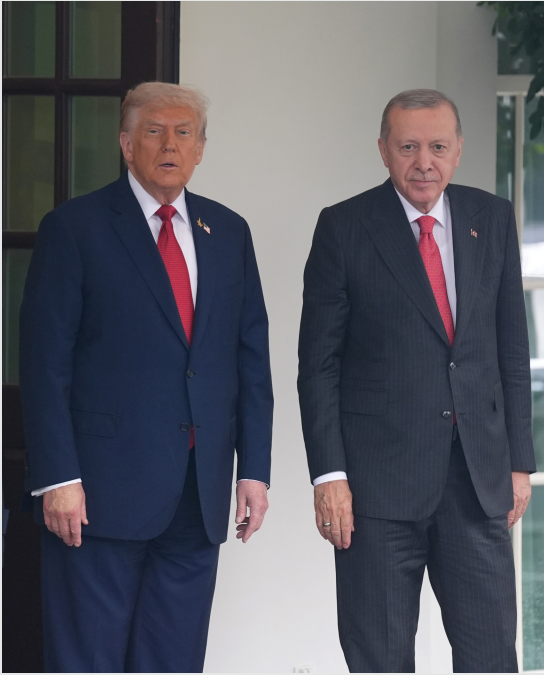
During the meeting with UN Secretary-General Antonio Guterres in New York, President Erdoğan reminded the need for reform within the United Nations system, affirming that Türkiye will continue to contribute to the process. The discussion covered key regional and global issues, including Israel's attacks on Gaza and the Russia-Ukraine war. President Erdoğan stated that Israel's aggression targets not only the Palestinians but also regional and global peace, calling for uninterrupted humanitarian access to Gaza and emphasizing Türkiye's ongoing efforts toward an immediate ceasefire and lasting peace.

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Türkiye Showcases Renewable Energy Leadership at UN Climate Summit

At the UN Climate Summit, President Erdoğan announced that Türkiye has increased the share of renewable energy in its total installed capacity to over 60 percent. President Erdoğan underlined Türkiye's commitment to its 2053 net-zero emissions goal, emphasizing ongoing efforts to expand low-carbon technologies, electric vehicle production, and railway investments. President Erdoğan noted that Türkiye's climate strategy is built on seven pillars and aims to cut emissions by 466 million tons by 2035, reaffirming Türkiye's readiness to host the COP31 summit in 2026.

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President Erdoğan Meets President Trump in Washington D.C.

President Erdoğan attended a meeting with US President Trump at the White House, which included the signing of a memorandum to enhance cooperation in civilian nuclear energy. The meeting also touched on deepening trade relations and military cooperation, regarding potential deals for F-16 fighter jets and ongoing talks about the F-35 program. Both leaders expressed optimism about forthcoming announcements that will strengthen the bilateral partnership between two countries.

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President Erdoğan Calls for Stronger Sanctions and Legal Action Against Israel at OIC-Arab League Summit

Speaking at the OIC-Arab League Extraordinary Summit in Doha, President Erdoğan strongly condemned Israel's actions in Gaza and the wider region, labeling them as genocide and part of a broader plan to establish a "Greater Israel" through occupation and destabilization.

President Erdoğan warned that Israel's aggression now threatens not only Palestine but also neighboring countries and mediators like Qatar, and emphasized that the Islamic world must unite against this expansionist mindset. Reaffirming Türkiye's solidarity with Qatar, President Erdoğan called for increased diplomatic efforts, expanded sanctions, and international legal action to hold Israel accountable.

President Erdoğan also stressed the importance of developing self-sufficiency in key sectors, especially defense, and urged closer cooperation among Islamic countries to build long-term regional stability and support the establishment of a Palestinian state with East Jerusalem as its capital.

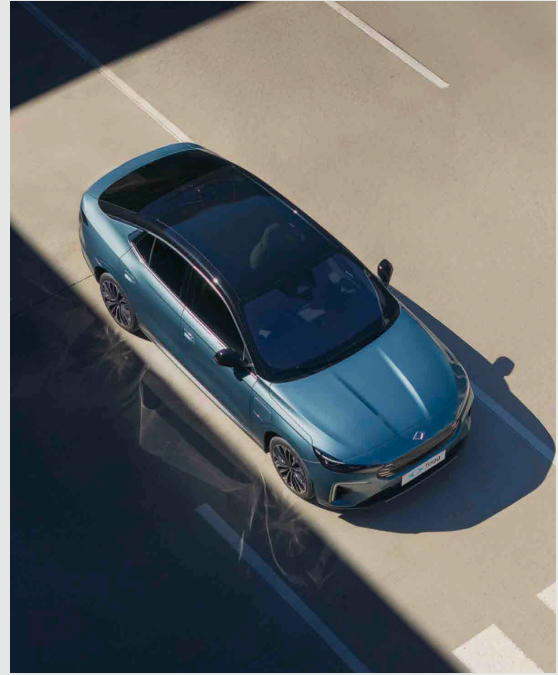
